Standards are domed and medium pink with a hint of lavender. The falls are medium pink, lighter toward the center of the petal and the hafts are darker pink. The edge of the falls have a half inch light blue lavender band. Bright red-orange beards. Good branching and bud count.

BOY GENIUS (Ghio 2012) BB, VE-E. S.
gold black tint at mid-rib: F. almost solid mahogany black, gold dotting around beards, gold hairline edge; beards gold.

Light orange, beards intense coral tangerine.




HOLIDAY IN MEXICO (Probst 2012) MTB
24" E-M. Bright yellow standards and style arms
are domed and lightly ruffled. Flared white ground
falls have contrasting red-purple veining and a 1/8"
yellow edge. Nice branching and bud count typical of
miniature tall bearded iris. Floriferous!

LACED ORANGEADE (M. Sutton 2011) S. orange;
F. dark orange veining and nectarine orange beards.

MODERN DRAMA (Kerr 2012) TB 38" M Modern
it is with great form and complex patterning of the
falls. This is the 'Queen's Circle' pattern with a



completely different set of colors applied delicately
in some areas, boldly in others. The epitome of this
breeding line. S. and style arms orange; F. apricot,
lighter around beards, veined darker, 1/2" brick red
edge; beards nasturtium red, slight sweet fragrance.

RETURN TO OZ (Kerr 2012) TB 42" M Here is a
big red bearded amoena whose breeding potential has
yet to be explored. Makes a good show in the border
as well as a good impression with visitors. It has an
undescribable quality of personality that must be
seen to be appreciated. Good flower, great stalks. S.
light blue with darker blue infusion from base; style
arms light blue; F. dark gentian blue; beards tangerine
red in throat to middle ending in white; slight sweet
fragrance. *[photo next page]*

SPENDTHRIFT (Keppel 2012) TB, EM. S. leghorn buff shaded pastel lobelia violet toward center; style arms leghorn buff; F. cotinga purple lighting away from center, narrow leghorn buff edge and faint veining, light apricot around ivory heart; beards golden poppy, cream base; luminata. SPRING AWAKENING (Kerr 2013) TB 42" M. Standards and style crests light yellow. Falls white with medium blue edge. Beards tangerine red. [photo page 6]

TWIN CITIES (M. Sutton 2011) S. yellow veined, edged white; F. white around yellow gold beards blending into violet blue starburst into plum purple. Reblooms zone 9. [photo page 1]

WATERLINE (Keppel 2012) TB EM. S. pale blue shading deeper in lower center, style arms light blue, F. blue-white 1/4" light blue edge band; beards carnelian red. [photo below]

Directions to the Garden Center:

666 Bellevue Avenue, Oakland

From the north or west: take Highway 580 or 24 to 980; take the West 27th Street/Grand Avenue exit, turn left on 27th Street, go east to Grand Avenue, watch for Lake Merritt on the right, take a left on to Grand Ave., then a right at the stoplight into the park. Proceed on Bellevue to the Garden Center. **From the south or east:** take the Lakeside (Lake Merritt) or Grand Ave. exit in Oakland; follow around the lake on the north and west side to Grand Ave. and Bellevue, turn left into the park.

Proceed to the Garden Center, park on either side of the road. We hope you can come -- everyone is welcome!

[On weekends only -- Expect to pay \$5.00 at the toll booth to park.

AC Transit Bus -- AC Transit bus #12 runs on Grand near the entrance to the park -- check transit before planning, as routes do change.
