Angels Abound (Kerr 2014) TB, 38" Midseason bloom. Standards white, pink at base; style arms white; Falls same, pink at hafts; beards red; slight sweet fragrance. Rainbow Acres 2014.

Bold Awakening AB (Tasco 2016) AB (OGB, 1/2 aril), 33", EML. Parentage= 07-AB-50-33:(Aztec Prince x 04-AB-03-09:(Bagdad's Folly x Energizer)) X Exotic Treasure

Cool Operator (M. Sutton 2016) 37" Early, mid, and late season bloomer. Pure white standards with white falls that are marbled blue-violet at the edges. Ruffled petals with good substance. 7 buds. Late rebloomer so should have nice rebloom in warmer climates.

Even Flow (Lauer 2016) M-L 34" S. tangerine orange, slight rose flush in the lower midrib; F. white center with tangerine shoulders and rim; B. mandarin red; ruffled, and lightly laced, slight sweet fragrance; two branches and spur, 7-9 bud per stock. It's a sib to Butterscotch Peach Parfait without the horn. Good show for later in the season.

French Lessons (Kerr 2014) TB, 36" Midseason bloom. Standards inside white with yellow edge, outside variable from solid yellow to yellow with darker veins blending to white with yellow edge; style arms dark yellow; Falls white, heavy yellow veining, large yellow hafts, yellow inside rim, white edge, sometimes with ephemeral short lavender lines between veins mid-fall; beards dark



yellow; slight sweet fragrance. (photo left)

Front of the Line (Ghio 2016) TB; 34"; EM; S. rusty mahogany red; F. gold ground overlaid mahogany red to near dotting at razor thin gold edge; Serrated petal edges; Very ruffled. (see photo p. 8)

Funfetti BB (L. Painter 2016) 24" M Border Bearded. Standards and styles are orange. Falls have a white ground overlaid red-ground plicata pattern with 1/4" orange edge. Beards are orange. Musky fragrance.

Ghirardelli Square (Keppel 2016) EM 38" One way to get your chocolate fix! Reddish chocolate and warm white plicata, beards mustard tan to violet. Exact color of chocolate varies with the weather, and the fall ring is slightly more purpletoned.

Give It Away (Lauer 2016) E-M 33' S. white with a thin canary yellow rim and at the base of the pedal; F. white base with canary yellow shoulders and rim, magenta rose lines from the beard to a solid coloring of magenta rose on the rim; B. tangerine orange; ruffled, pronounced sweet fragrance; two way branching with 7 plus buds. On occasion it has had a summer or fall bloom but not consistence so not to be confused as a rebloomer but I have used it as a pod and pollen parent for reblooming crosses. Results yet to be confirmed.









Key to My Heart (Kerr 2014) TB, 36" Midseason bloom. Standards and style arms light orange; Falls lavender-blue, large pink-white center, orange hafts, dark lavender edge; beards orange, tips red; slight sweet fragrance.

Lemon Jade (J. Painter 2015) M. This greenish yellow self has slightly darker standards and darker fall shoulders. Gold beards.

Rust Never Sleeps (Lauer 2013) IB. 18 inch. Early to midseason bloom and rebloom. Standards cinnamon (RHS 165D), aster-violet midrib (87C); style arms cinnamon; falls squirrel-brown (166B); beards majolica-yellow (169C) in throat and middle, bluebird-blue (94C) at end; pronounced sweet fragrance; ruffled (photo below right)

Spring Awakening (Kerr 2013) TB, 42" Midseason bloom. Standards and style arms light yellow; falls white with medium blue edge; beards white base, hairs tipped tangerine orange. (photo below)

Thrill Ride (M. Sutton 2015) New, wild and unique! Greyed orange standards (upper petals) are flushed yellow at the base and up the mid ribs. Vivid imperial purple falls (lower petals) have a distinct and contrasting 1/2" ruby red rim. Wonderful branching with 7 to 10 buds on tall stalks. 35" tall, blooms mid to late season. *(photo p. 1)*

From the north or west: take Highway 580 or 24 to 980; take the West 27th Street/Grand Avenue exit, turn left on 27th Street, go east to Grand Avenue, watch for Lake Merritt on the right, take a left on to Grand Ave., then a right at the stoplight into the park. Proceed on Bellevue to the Garden Center. From the south or east: take the Lakeside (Lake Merritt) or Grand Ave. exit in Oakland; follow around the lake on the north and west side to Grand Ave. and Bellevue, turn left into the park.

Proceed to the Garden Center, park on either side of the road. We hope you can come -- everyone is welcome!
